
The Phone - Iridium 9555 and Accessories

Features:

- Volume key on Left side of phone
- Power port under rubber flap on Left side of phone
- Right "soft key" for HELP
- Headset port under rubber flap on Right side of phone
- Remove rubber plug on back/top to connect automobile antenna

Accessories:

- AC and DC charger adapters are included in carrying case
- Magnetic automobile antenna can be affixed to car roof
- Phone numbers and instructions stored under the "egg crate" foam panel in the lid of the Pelican carrying case



Preparation Tips

- Charge phone approximately every 4 months (create a calendar reminder)
 - Batteries should be completely drained before charging to optimize battery performance.
- Designate calling locations, plus alternatives
- Periodically verify or print out a new satellite phone contact list





Tips for Good Reception

• The phone must be **used outside** and away from trees and tall buildings. Best reception requires approximately 140° of view above the horizon in all directions, and nearest building should be more than 40 feet away. (Unless used with the optional cradle and indoor antenna.)

Visibilia.

Fully extend the handset antenna.

Rotate the antenna so it is pointing directly up.



Making a Satellite Phone Call

- When outside, <u>press and hold</u> round power button on top of phone to turn ON (and OFF).
- Wait for "REGISTERED" to displayon screen. This may take up to 30 seconds. Do not attempt to place a call if the satellite phone does not register and have signal bars.
- Optimal signal strength is 3 bars or more shown in the upper left corner of the display
- Status indicator flashes GREEN when there is a signal; RED when there is no signal.
- Free satellite phone test calls may be made by calling:

$$00 - 1 - 480 - 752 - 5105$$

Be aware that satellite phone calls are expensive – high rates apply!

Satellite Phone to Cell or Landline Phone

Cell or Landline Phone to Satellite Phone (saves \$!)

Dial local number assigned to satellite phone

$$1 - 802 - 123 - 4567$$

satellite phone to satellite phone reduces the chance of poor reception/failure




Satellite Phone Text Messaging

Free and Unlimited Web-based Text Messaging to Sat Phone:

- *** Recommended for non-urgent communication; messages stored for 1 week
- Go to: www.iridium.com
- At the Homepage, point on 'Support,' and select 'Send a Satellite Message'
- Enter the 12-digit Iridium telephone number; skip the 'Reply Email' box unless using reply texting from sat phone
- Type in message up to 160 characters in the large box
- Click send message; message will appear on the receiver's sat phone display
- Web browsers must allow reCAPTCHA functionality to support this capability

Satellite Phone Text Messaging

Sat Phone texting to Sat or Cell Phone:

- From Main menu screen, select 'Messages'
- Select 'Create Message,' and write your message in the message area, and then select 'Options'
- Select 'Send,' and enter number at 'New Recipient,' or select from any pre-saved numbers, press 'OK,' and hit 'Send'
